
NECMT Parking for the Bernhard Music Center

Given that NECMT is happening during Spring Break at Williams College, parking on campus should not be difficult (though staff will still be working on Friday April 4).



The parking lot closest to the Bernhard Music Center (red BMC on the map) is directly behind the building (yellow #1 on the map). Reach this by turning north on Park St. from Rte. 2 and taking the first right onto Mission Park Drive. If spots are not available there, continue down Mission Park Drive to the lot shown as yellow #2 (some of those spots are permit-only for electric vehicles). Ample visitor parking can be found even further down Mission Park Drive (yellow #3 on the map) or in the campus parking garage (yellow #4). To reach the garage, turn left off Park Drive onto Whitman St. (the street opposite to Mission Park) and another left onto Adams Memorial Theater Drive. Parking is also likely available (Friday in particular) in the parking lot behind the Congregational Church. This is reached by turning north onto Chapin Hall Drive. Some of the spots in this lot are owned by Williams College (marked Faculty and Staff); others are owned by the church. There is also street parking on Chapin Hall Drive. DO NOT park on the street on Park Drive: there is a 2-hour parking limit vigorously enforced by the Williamstown Police Department, and they regularly ticket vehicles. There is also enforced 1-hour parking on Spring Street (the main commercial street in town) during the day, but free parking in the town lot at the end of Spring Street.

Handicapped access to the Bernhard Music Center is best approached from parking lot #1 on the map. There is a ramp from the lot to the building, and an elevator down the hall from the ground floor entrance, which one can take to the second-floor lobby where the conference will take place.
